6. English Department -- partial funding: 2700 (does not include software request)

- A. Good for student to know about

**8. Computer upgrade for Software:**

A. Have a 5 minutes presentation brought to us for next meeting.

B. use google docs for some of the computer needs not useful -- takes too much time to change settings (like fixing old Word Perfect documents into Word format)

**9. Money for Social Studies Dept. books:**

A. approve \$3,000.00 if books are kept in the library where they can keep track of them through the barcode system.

**10 ESL Aide**

A. A lot of money is spent on this, but funding has been drastically cut.

B. Aides are great; not only in the ESL classrooms but in the sheltered content area classrooms

C. Aids help counselors know where to place these students for the next year.

B. 2/3 to 3/4 passing Algebra 1 now/great success

C. Approve \$8,000.00

D. UVU pays for half (college students working towards becoming teachers)

**14. IB Curriculum for Level 2**

A. Help teachers become level 2

B. need to help teachers become great

C. \$5,000.00 to train teachers/this would cost \$750 per teachers to help the reach level 2 (great price)

D. It is located here in Utah so we do not have to pay for airfare or lodging

E. Needs to be done every 5 years.

**15. Library Books**

- A. approve \$3,500
