- Students are not enrolled until they are admitted to UVU and have registered through UV Link. Instructions and deadlines are posted on the Distance Education Web page, http://www.uvsc.edu/disted/li/register.php.
- Students who participate in Live Interactive Concurrent Enrollment will generate an official UVU transcript.
- Students are required to have and maintain a cumulative 3.0 GPA to participate in the Live Interactive Program.
- UVU final grades will be assigned by the UVU Instructor at the end of each semester
- Credits are transferable to all colleges and universities. Contact the receiving institution to determine how the credits will be applied.
- If a registered Live Interactive student drops the course at the high school, the student must also go to UV-Link and drop the course in order to avoid a failing grade on the college transcript.
- Sophomore students must fill out the "Sophomore Permission" form and attached the required documentation in order to participate in live interactive classes.
- Sophomore students must have and maintain a 3.5 GPA to participate.
