MUST DO TO PARTICIPATE IN GRADUATION CEREMONY:

Seniors walking in the graduation ceremony must clear CREDIT and graduation application with the COUNSELING CENTER. All FEES must be paid in the BUSINESS OFFICE before you can qualify to pick up your cap and gown or walk at Graduation.

Seniors who wish to participate in the graduation ceremony have agreed to the following dress and behavior expectations:

- Show respect for self and others.
- Abide by PHS Dress Code for modesty
- Wear dress/skirt or slacks/collared shirt (with tie preferred)
- Wear dress shoes or dress sandals (no flip flops)
- Wear only authorized cords and collars (NHS) with gowns, with the possible addition of only one floral lei.
- Refrain from bringing or throwing disruptive objects such as beach balls, etc.
- Listen appropriately during entire ceremony (**no cell phones allowed**)
- Attendees who disrupt the Graduation Ceremony will be escorted from the building and can pick up their diploma the following day from the principal.
