What is it?

Electronic seal placed on your high school transcript that shows future employers and colleges your proficiency in English and another foreign language.

Can it be any language?

Yes! In addition to English, your second language can be any world language or dialect. If you are unsure of what exam you need to take to test your second language proficiency, please visit your counselor.

What do I need to do?

1. Check with your counselor if you have taken any English proficiency exams (see examples of right) and have an adequate score.
2. With the help of your counselor, sign up for the AAPPL exam or any other foreign language proficiency exam (see examples on the right)
3. Show off your seal!
