

How Do I Calculate My Honor Score?

You must have a 3.2 cumulative G.P.A. or higher and have earned an Honor Score of at least 19 to earn an Honor Distinction. Any students with a G.P.A less than 3.2 will not have honor points calculated toward an Honor Score.

Please note: Final Honor Scores senior year are based on cumulative G.P.A. and honor points after the 3rd term of the Senior year. This information will be used for recognition at the graduation ceremony. If a student's cumulative G.P.A. changes after the end of year grading period and qualifies a student for a Honor Distinction, the Distinction will be reflected on the final transcript. Additionally, if a student's Honor Score and/or Distinction are altered (increased or decreased) as a result of final grades, that Distinction will be reflected on the transcript as well.

You must successfully pass and complete a class to receive the designated honor points.

- **Summa Cum Laude** (With Highest Honor/Distinction), Honor Score of 64 or greater
- **Magna Cum Laude** (With Great Honor/Distinction), Honor Score ranging from: 41-63
- **Cum Laude** (With Honor/Distinction), Honor Score ranging from: 19-40

Can I earn honor points for courses I completed at another school?

Transfer students will receive honor points toward the Honor System for Advanced Placement (AP) and Distance Education (DE) courses passed and completed at their previous school. Due to the varying nature of how honors classes are designated in other schools, honors classes besides Advanced Placement and Distance Education (DE) may not be granted to transfer students as honor points toward the Honor System.

Advanced Placement Courses = 1.0 honor point per semester for each course completed and passed.
