- II. Attendance Data (Tory Norman)
- a. Tory Norman shared what he found when he gathered more data on attendance issues. In summary he found that our most at risk groups when it comes to attendance are our Hispanic and Pacific Island students.
- III. School Report Card
- a. Mrs. Alvarez shared the school data on Data Gateway. The number of students getting an 18 or higher on the ACT did improve which was one of the former goals of the Community Council. In addition, Provo High has a strong number of students enrolling in CE classes and CTE tracks.
